TRAFFIC LIGHT

Every day is different. Pay attention to the traffic light signals:



Red means VOICE ONLY.

Yellow means VOICE AND TOUCH ONLY

Green means VOICE, TOUCH, AND SHOW.

Your nurse can help you identify what kind of day your baby is having.



CHANTING

Chanting has many benefits.



Let's chant! Mommy/Daddy Loves You

Chant around the circle.



KITS

Let's explore the kits! Safety and hygiene are important...



MEET THE MONKEYS **Baby's eyes develop in stages**



Let's recite following the traffic light signals.

MORE BODY RHYMES Personalize a Classic Song



Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star



Talking and singing with your baby builds vocabulary. Talking and singing builds your baby's brain, too!

Use Quietly

Take out the shaker eggs.

Wiggle! March! Let's talk about the pictures... Can we make up a story?



Wiggle! March! & Old MacDonald Use the pictures as reminders. Let's sing about the animals.

Remember to sing softly and slowly, and to watch for signals.



PUBLIC LIBRARIES

Visit Your Library!

Most public libraries offer free programs for babies!

Babies need to be healthy before attending a group program and may not be allowed to attend during flu season. Check with your baby's doctor before attending a group program.



Bedtime routines are calming and help your baby get ready for sleep.

They can involve:

- reading a book aloud,
- singing a lullaby,
- giving baby a bath,
- feeding,
- or anything we've done in Goslings!
