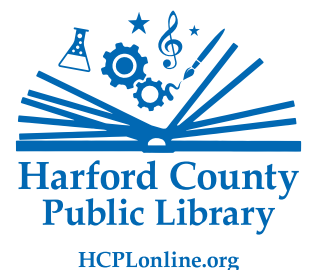


Reading and singing helps
